About the Artist



Jim Brown started his musical experience by playing the trombone in his elementary, intermediate, and high school bands and singing in various choral groups throughout his school

years. Jim began studying the organ in early 1974 at the age of 18. His organ studies were self-taught initially. Jim then studied classical organ and piano with Terry Compton of Roseville,

CA and has also studied with Donna Crosson of Shingle Springs, CA

He got his first professional break in December, 1975 when he was hired to play the theater pipe organ at Big Top Pizza in Carmichael, CA. He held this position until 1981. He later played the pipe organs at Pizza and Pipes, both in Sacramento and in Fresno, CA until 1994. He started playing the organ for church services in July, 1981 and has been playing almost non stop ever since. He moved to Spokane, WA in December, 2005 after his retirement from the City of Roseville, CA, and just recently returned to Sacramento. He and his family live in Lincoln, CA, and he just recently became organist at Fair Oaks Presbyterian Church.
