Jim Brown started his musical experience by playing the trombone in his elementary, intermediate and high school

bands and singing in various choral groups throughout his school years. He began studying the organ in early 1974 at the age of 18 shortly after graduating mid-term from high

school. His organ studies were self- taught initially. Jim then studied classical organ and piano with Terry Compton of Roseville, California, and has also studied with Donna Crosson of Shingle Springs, California.

His first professional break came in December, 1975, when he was hired to play the theater pipe organ at Big Top Pizza in Carmichael, California. He held this position until 1981. He also played the theater pipe organs at Pizza and Pipes as their substitute organist, both in Sacramento and in Fresno, California. He started playing the organ for church services in July, 1981 and has been playing almost non stop ever since. He and his family moved to Spokane, Washington, in December, 2005, after his retirement from the City of Roseville, California. He returned to the Sacramento area in November, 2016.

Jim, his wife Denise, and daughter Melissa reside in Auburn, California. He is currently organist and office administrator at Lincoln Hills Community Church.
